Gregory H. Robinson is the UGA Foundation Distinguished Professor of Chemistry in the Franklin College of Arts and Sciences. Robinson's research has fundamentally changed the way scientists view the nature of the chemical bonds between earth-abundant elements. His findings could ultimately play a role in improved computer chips.
